Additional teaching assistants to deliver daily phonics in Key 1	To provide daily small group phonics sessions	£3920.44
One to One support	To support individual children with identified need	£17 123.50
Breakfast	To provide pupil children with milk and toast	£500
Uniform subsidy	To provide pupil premium pupils with funding to subsidise the purchase of uniform	£300
Daily intervention	To provide daily small group intervention sessions for pupil premium children where gaps in progress and attainment have been identified	£7 200
Better Reading Programme delivery	To provide additional support in Years 6 for 0.5 hours a day to teach pupil premium pupils	£4 050
